3. General Rules

- The rules of the CMAS (2012/03) are valid. Every club and team, which is acknowledged by the VDST and whose athletes are in possession of a VDST computer number is eligible.
- Open to all clubs and their athletes with a valid right to start the CMAS Finswimming competitions and athletes foreign clubs that are registered in their state association or in the CMAS. The medical examination must be on race day not earlier than one year.

- The session of the team leaders and referees take place half an hour before the beginning of the competition. Valid competition cards of the athletes must be handed over at the office until the deadline for application.
- It's possible to refill diving equipment on location (max. pressure of 200 bar). Only diving equipment with valid technical inspection is to be used. Please pay attention to the transport of dangerous material.
- **Contrary to the rule are filled pressure air bottles to bring along!**
- For lack of time can be shortened or eliminated the breaks, as then only the medal ceremonies for the age classes D, E and F performed. The certificates for the other rating classes may be issued at the end of the event.

4. One-Start-Rule

- For the entire competition is considered the "one-start rule".
- The start is basically the starting block and the competition for the 50 FS using a snorkel for breathing is mandatory. Masters are allowed to start without a snorkel.

*) It is to declare at the starting application, if the competitor starts in category A or AK25. This choice is obligatory for all starts of the competitor.

The places 1-6 will receive certificates. For more information about the awards ceremony under item 3 of this tender.

The German Record is equated with 1000 score points. Each athlete receives score points for his/her performance according to a 1000 score points scale. The **two** best results are valid for final ranking. The points will be added separately for men and the athlete with the highest score in each category receives the winner's cup (a cake). In case of level score, the higher score on the best single distance counts. If there is

still level score the younger athlete wins.

7. Protests

Protest must take place in written form within 30 minutes after announcement of the results on a deposit of 30,00 Euro.
